

Welcome to the pre-conference meeting

Exciting fertility data in the U.S.

Time: Wednesday, April 12, 2023 | 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM EDT

Place: Hyatt Regency New Orleans (Strand 7), New Orleans, Louisiana

Description: The U.S. Census Bureau now makes restricted-use administrative birth data available through the Census Numident for nearly all U.S. births for more than the last century, and most births since 1997 are linked to parents through the Census Household Composition Key (CHCK). These data are not well-known and underutilized to study births, fertility, and family in the U.S. Yet, they offer large potential for instance for parity-specific fertility analysis.

The meeting will discuss the qualities and potential of these new data sources, as well as enable a dialogue between U.S. and European fertility researchers working with administrative data. The meeting will begin with talks given by Katie Genadek (U.S. Census Bureau) and Leslie Root (University of Colorado Boulder), and it will continue with a discussion. Gunnar Andersson (Stockholm University) will chair the meeting.

Participation: The meeting is open to all PAA 2023 attendees, and no pre-registration is required for attending.

Organizer: The meeting is organized by the EAPS (European Association for Population Studies) Working Group Register-Based Fertility Research.
